

## Office/Store hours: 9am-6pm daily

(9am-5pm in the winter)

**Cabins & Yurts:** check in at 2:00, check out at noon.

### Park Rules

\*subject to change at any time by management\*

\*Park speed limit is 5mph no exceptions! Obey stop signs. Watch for Children.

\*All Tents, Cabins, and Yurts must be checked in no later than 9pm.

\*RVs pull into Late Night Parking after 9pm.

\*Visitors must check in at the office.

\*Quiet time is between 10pm and 7am. Excessive noise will not be tolerated.

\*The owners of this park will not be responsible for fire, theft, damage, vandalism, accidents, or any act of God to persons or property.

\*Any damage to Arrowhead property by guests, thier visitors, pets or vehicles will be charged to the guest's card on file.

\*Management reserves the right to require any guest to vacate the park for any behavior that disturbs other guests. Violence of any kind upon people, animals, or property will result in immediate removal from the property, and law enforcement will be notified.

\*Keep your area and our facilities clean and free fom unnecessary clutter. Respect other guests at all times.

\*NO SMOKING OR PETS inside ANY of our park facilities including Cabins and Yurts.

\*Children need to be under parental supervision at all times including restrooms, nature trails and near the river. Parents are responsible for their children's conduct and safety.

\*Open fires in fire pits or free-standing units only. Fire pits and grills must be on concrete or gravel, NEVER directly on the grass. Extinguish fires after EVERY USE. Do NOT put grills or greasy items on picnic tables.

\*Each guest is responsible for their own RV hoses and utility connections. Use of sewer donut elbow or airtight connection required. Parts for sale in the store.

\*Please ONLY use RV safe toilet paper in our sewer lines. Do NOT flush wet wipes or any other sanitary products! Do not pour grease down your drains.

\*DO NOT DRIVE ON GRASS, over sprinklers or concrete slabs! Additional parking in our overflow lots.

\*DO NOT drive anything into the ground to avoid damaging utility lines. (Tent sites are the exception) NO TENTS IN RV SPACES. NO screen rooms, rugs, or tarps on grass.

\*Tents can be put up in the tent area only. No more than 2 tents per site. Tents must be moved every 3 days to water and mow the grass. Vehicles must be parked in tent parking lot, never on the roadway.

\*Prepare for automatic sprinklers that come on every night. Some are set for twice a day. The park is not responsible for water damage to any items left out.

\*NO REFUNDS for early departure. If a tenant vacates a space before the end of the paid-up period, management reserves all rights to that space. Spaces may NOT be rented or subleased.

\*Clotheslines, unsightly furniture, and major vehicle/RV repairs not allowed.

\*Please respect the campground boundaries and any "No trespassing signs"

\*Place ALL garbage in designated cans or dumpsters in the park.

\*Restrooms, showers and laundry facilities are for registered guests and visitors only.

\*The horses do not belong to Arrowhead Park. Please be courteous and respectful. Obey all signs. NEVER open the gate.

### Pet Policy

If your pet creates a disturbance or is a nuisance to other campers, you may be asked to leave. The pet's owner is responsible for any expenses and liability related to a pet attack or damage inside Arrowhead Park. To keep our park clean and pet friendly, please follow these rules:

#### CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET IMMEDIATELY

All droppings must be sealed in a bag and disposed of in a trash \* Your pets shall remain in your CONTROL and visual observation at ALL times \* Pets must be on a controllable leash at ALL times \* Dogs should NEVER be left tied up or unattended outside \* No pets in ANY park facilities including cabins and yurts \* Excessive barking, aggressive behavior and disruptive noise is not acceptable \* Pets may NOT be tied to any trees, posts, hydrants, signs or ANY property structures \* Be aware and respect other guests and pet owners at all times throughout the park \* Keep your pets away from flower beds, gardens and totem poles \* Violation of our pet policies may result in removal from our park.

### OHV/ATV Policy

Always show respect to other guests when entering and exiting the park. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of ALL our guests, please follow these rules:  
YOU MUST STAY ON DESIGNATED ROADWAYS AT ALL TIMES \* NEVER ride on our grass \* OHV's must obey "No trespassing" signs \* All OHV's must be parked within the confines of your campsite driveway \* Additional OHV and trailer parking available in overflow parking or secured storage \* All riders must adhere to Idaho State and local laws applicable; OHV registration/ plates, helmet and age restrictions \* Any OHV deemed excessively loud may be restricted from operation in the park \* The OHV's owner is responsible for any expenses and liability to damage inside Arrowhead RV Park.
